1. Background, Role of GoB, Stakeholders and Technical Assistance

1.1 Introduction and Background

The Government of Balochistan promulgated the Community Led Local Governance Policy on 31 March 2023, which aims to improve the local government system by incorporating mobilized communities and empowering citizens. The policy was developed by the Local Government and Rural Development Department with the support of the European Union-funded BRACE Technical Assistance (TA) Project

This report provides the Media Coverage and Newspaper Clippings on the Community Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy Promulgation by the Provincial Cabinet, of the Government of Balochistan, explaining the roles played by the Local Government and Rural Development Department, all stakeholders, the European Union, and the BRACE Technical Assistance Project implemented by DAI.

1.2 Role of the Local Government and Rural Development Department

The Local Government and Rural Development Department played the lead role in the development of the Community Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy. The CLLG policy is housed within, and its implementation will be led by the LGRD Department through a dedicated CLLG institutional setup.

The GoB CLLG Policy recognizes the importance of listening to the needs and priorities of the people and acknowledges their right to social services delivery to the people at their doorstep. The CLLG Policy regulates and encourages greater participation of grassroots communities in the local development processes and strengthens local governance by empowering the third tier of local government, the Local Councils and the Local Communities. This empowerment will be ensured through the integration of the Community bottom-up planning and the top-down investments of the government in the local development processes.

The LGRD Department has developed the policy after extensive consultations with all relevant Government Departments including but not limited to Planning & Development Department, Finance Department, Women Development Department, Social Welfare Department, the Office of Chief Secretary, selected Provincial and District Officials, and with the relevant other stakeholders, that included the BRACE Programme implementing Partners, the Rural Support Programmes (RSPs), stakeholders from Civil Society Organizations. And selected Development Partners. The Policy formulation process was facilitated by the BRACE Technical Assistance Project, implemented by DAI Global/Pakistan, which is funded by the European Union.

1.3 Role of other stakeholders in development of Community Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy

The CLLG policy regulates and promotes the collaborative efforts between all relevant stakeholders in the planning, financing, and implementation processes of local public sector local development and public services delivery. The CLLG policy's implementation will result in improved social public services delivery and stronger accountability in the management of local resources and local government with priorities of the grassroot communities fully acknowledged through a vigorous process of planning, identifying and prioritising the community development interventions. The policy targets the sustainable uplift of the rural and urban poor, and the beneficiaries will include citizens, communities, elected Local Council Bodies, government departments and the non-profit organizations.

The Community Led Local Governance Policy involved all relevant stakeholders, including the Government departments Local Government and rural development department, Women Development Department, Planning and Development Department, Finance Department and Social welfare department, the district stakeholders, district administration, the local communities, BRACE Programme, Rural Support Programmes, and Civil Society members. The CLLG policy consultative processes were conducted from 2018 to 2021, and all above-mentioned stakeholders have contributed and played their due role in the finalization of the GoB CLLG Policy. Their participation was structured through bilateral and group consultative process, with Notified

working groups (WGs), a LGRD Sectoral Coordination Committee (SCC), and the BRACE Strategy and Policy Dialogue Committee (SPDC) ultimately endorsing the draft Policy in September 2022.

1.4 Role of the European Union

The European Union played a crucial role in the development of the GoB Community Led Local Governance Policy. The EU has funded various community-based development and empowerment initiatives in the country and specifically in the Balochistan Province.

In the context of formulation of GoB CLLG Policy, the European Union (EU) funded BRACE Programme (2017-23) and its precursor, in 2013, Balochistan Community Development Programme (BCDP). Formed the basis for the GoB CLLG Policy, as the positive results of the BCDP and the Programme BRACE, with respect to social mobilisation and capacity development for enhanced social cohesion and improved social services, in engagement with local government and local authorities and other development actors, needed to be made sustainable and where possible scaled up.

The BRACE Technical Assistance Project was included in the BRACE Programme, to ensure that a Balochistan Community Led Development Framework would be developed, and support the Government of Balochistan to come up with a GoB CLLG Policy, including detailed implementation arrangements.

The EU financial assistance in the delivery of the two major BCDP and BRACE programmes and in the development of a GoB CLLG Policy clearly reflects the EU's commitment to promoting participatory governance and inclusive development, in Pakistan and in Balochistan in particular.

1.5 Role BRACE Technical Assistance Project, implemented by DAI

The BRACE Technical Assistance (TA) Project is implemented by DAI Global and provided technical support to the Local Government and Rural Development Department in the development of the Community Led Local Governance Policy.

The TA Project has played a significant role in coordinating the policy development process, engaging all stakeholders, and ensuring that the policy reflects the priorities of the Government of Balochistan. The TA Project has also supported the development of implementation procedures for the policy and has trained relevant stakeholders to apply these procedures.

1.6 Outline of the Way forward

The Government of Balochistan Community Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy is a paradigm changing and significant step towards promoting participatory governance and inclusive development in Balochistan. The CLLG policy implementation will involve all stakeholders and will result in improved service delivery, stronger accountability, and the sustainable uplift of the rural and urban poor.

The implementation of the Community Led Local Governance Policy is just to start and a long road lies ahead. Innovative Public Private Partnership collaborations between the Local Government & Rural Development Department, the Local Council Bodies, and the Mobilized Communities and Empowered Citizens, will be developed, this capitalizing on the strengths of all stakeholders.

A first and major challenge will be to ensure that there is adequate capacity at the provincial level and in the districts, especially with the district level Local Government. The second major challenge will be to mobilize the required budget resources. The Government of Balochistan intends to allocate a due share of its limited financial resources, and other funding sources. The contributions from international development partners remain very much needed and the EU has been one of Balochistan's leading development partners with regard to community mobilization.

The Government of Balochistan and CLLG Policy stakeholders hopes that the EU support may continue. The Government has already initiated request to the EUD and is mobilizing its own the human and monetary resources.

The GoB Community Led Local Governance Policy (CLLG) Policy

"The Government of Balochistan is to Take an Historic Step towards Devolved Local Governance and Empowered Community Participation through approval of GoB CLLG Policy!"

The Local Government & Rural Development Department has submitted the Government of Balochistan's Community-Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy to the Chief Secretary Office. The CLLG Policy was endorsed by the Strategy and Policy Dialogue Committee (SPDC) on 7 September 2022.

Prior to the submission to Chief Secretary Office, and for further procedural compliance, the CLLG Policy and the Policy Framework were duly submitted to the Finance Department for their opinion and further perusal. The Chief Secretary office will now formally submit the CLLG Policy to the Chief Minister's Secretariat.

Next, the Chief Minister's Secretariat is to submit the Balochistan Government's Community-Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy to the Provincial Cabinet for approval. The approval and full operationalization of the CLLG Policy will allow Community Institutions to receive and benefit from public sector funds, as well as become a partner in the GoB Local Governance and local development efforts, which are intended to provide improved services to rural and urban disadvantaged communities.





The Balochistan Local Government Act has been Amended to Formally Recognize the Role of Community Institutions

The Provincial Assembly of Balochistan, passed the proposed amendments in Local Government Act 2010 and adopted the Balochistan LG Act (Amended) 2022 wherein Section-87 was included which provides that a Local Council, subject to approval of the Local Government Board, may engage registered community Based Organizations (CBO), or Community Institutions (CI) in its local area development or execute such projects funded by the donor organizations/ agencies.

The registered and mobilized Community Institutions (CI) under this legal cover, are now formally recognized as partners in the Government Local Governance systems to take part in the local development processes.

The LG Act amendment, Section 87, will strengthen Community-Led Bottom-Up Planning and Development. and this provision is a major achievement of the LG&RD Department and the Government of Balochistan

This provision will also provide legal coverage to the proposed Community Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy,

The amendment of LGA Section 87 was prepared and promoted by the Local Government & Rural Development Department, with technical support from the BRACE TA Project. A key role in the adoption process was played by the Hon





Adoption of the GoB Community Led Local Governance Policy by the BRACE Strategy and Policy Dialogue Committee (SPDC)

The final draft of the GoB Community-led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy was approved by the BRACE SPDC Forum for onward submission to the GoB Authorities for its formal adoption.

The 6th BRACE Programme, Strategy and Policy Dialogue Committee (SPDC) of 7 September, chaired by the Additional Chief Secretary (ACS/Dev), endorsed the Balochistan Community-Led Local Governance (CLLG) Policy.

The CLLG Policy and the Policy Framework, provide a comprehensive development planning, fiscal, and regulatory framework that makes Community-Led Local Development a formal part of the GoB Local Governance systems. The GoB CLLG Policy will enhance the sustainability and will allow signification scaling up, of Community-Led Local development initiatives and investments, to be funded by Development Partners, and Government and from Community ownresources.

Following through on the Balochistan LG Act Amendment (Section 87),

the CLL Policy will regulate how Community Institutions can access, or benefit from public sector funds, and become a full partner in the GoB Local Governance and local development processes, that aim at increased service delivery to the rural and urban poor.

The Additional Chief Secretary (ACS/Dev) appreciated the efforts of the Local Government Department and BRACE Technical Assistance (TA) Team in developing this transformational GoB Policy and the supporting governance framework. The Local Government and Rural Development Department (LGRDD) will implement the CLLG Policy together with the key

and the Local Councils

A comprehensive capacity-building programme is to be developed and to ensure adoption and implementation of the CLLG Policy. The Balochistan Rural Development Academy (BRDA) is to be strengthened and is to play a lead role, in building capacity of relevant provincial Departments, the district administrations, the elected local government officials, and the beneficiaries at local level.

The CLLG Policy builds on the poverty-reduction evidence and the proven effective Community Mobilization (CM)

approached of the BRACE Programme, as applied by the Rural Support Programmes (RSP) and other CM NGOs. Poverty reduction Impact studies have provided the evidence, that mobilized and empowered Community Organizations and Citizens, facilitate Local Government and other Government Department to increase and sustain their outreach to the rural/urban poor, resulting in more sustained and improved access to, and better quality of front-line public services delivery. Under the BRACE Programme this is done through small-scale community physical infrastructure (CPI) schemes, and a mix of CM stimuli that cover TVET, Community Investment Fund (CIF) loans, Income Generating (IGCG) Brants, support to People with Special Needs (PWSN), and a range of other CM support measures, that are identified and then self-prioritized by the mobilized Communities in their respective Community/Village and UC Development Plans (VDP/UCDP). The GoB CLLG Policy provides the Implementation and Regulation Framework and proposes Fiscal Allocations, to continue this CM approach more sustainably aiming at scaling up to cover the all relevant Districts of Balochistan and the whole target group of poor families living below the poverty line. The CLLG provides the GoB with a forum for better outreach into the villages and this CLLG platform may also facilitate implementation of relief and mitigation programme of natural or man-made disasters, in flood affected districts.

The GoB CLLG Policy is a transformational governance framework, and at the local level it will rebuild the trust, especially of those citizens who did n9t yet receive their basic public services. At the global level the CLLG Policy may inspire enhanced trust with our development partners/ donors to commit more resources and join hands with the Balochistan Government, to reach out to local poor communities through this the CLLG Policy.
